

Training program on Fish Disease Management at Centre for Peninsular Aquatic Genetic Resources, ICAR-NBFGR

A three-day training program on 'Fish Disease Management' was organised during January 3-5, 2024 by the Centre for Peninsular Aquatic Genetic Resources, ICAR-NBFGR, Lucknow. This training was funded by the Department of Fisheries, Government of Kerala, and the program was organized as a part of National Surveillance Programme on Aquatic Animal Diseases (NSPAAD). The aim of this training programme was to sensitize the officials of the state fisheries department about disease management in aquaculture operations. About 15 officials representing all the districts of Kerala attended the training program. Both theoretical and practical sessions were conducted, allowing participants to gain hands-on experience in sample collection, storage, and the diagnosis of fish diseases.
